OUBLECK RECIPE

The beauty of this slime is that it only takes two ingredients, water and cornstarch at a ratio of 1:2.

- Add cornstarch to bowl.
- Let you child feel the powder.
- Pour in water, slowly. Mixture should thicken.
- Add food coloring. (Optional)

Time to get messy! The children will love the consistency. The mixture acts as a solid and a liquid.

After you finish with the fun, throw out your oobleck in the garbage.

FYI: The origin of the name oobleck is derived from the Dr. Seuss book, *Bartholomew and the Oobleck*.
