CPR and First Aid Training are separate required training and are not counted as part of the annual 21 hour Continuing Education requirement.

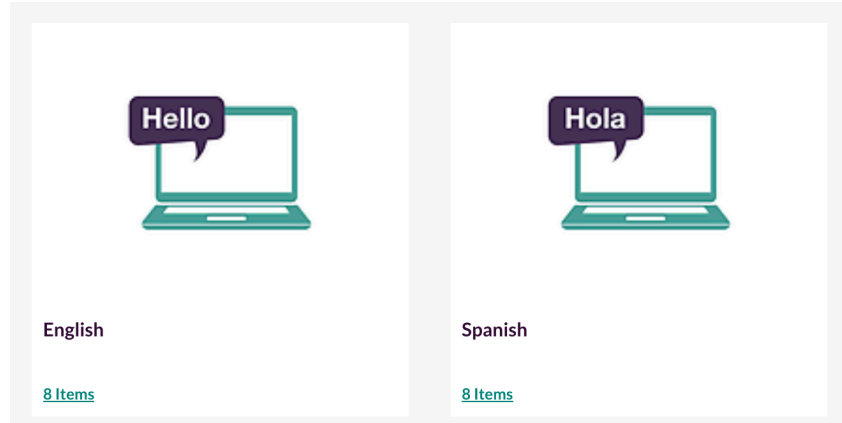
